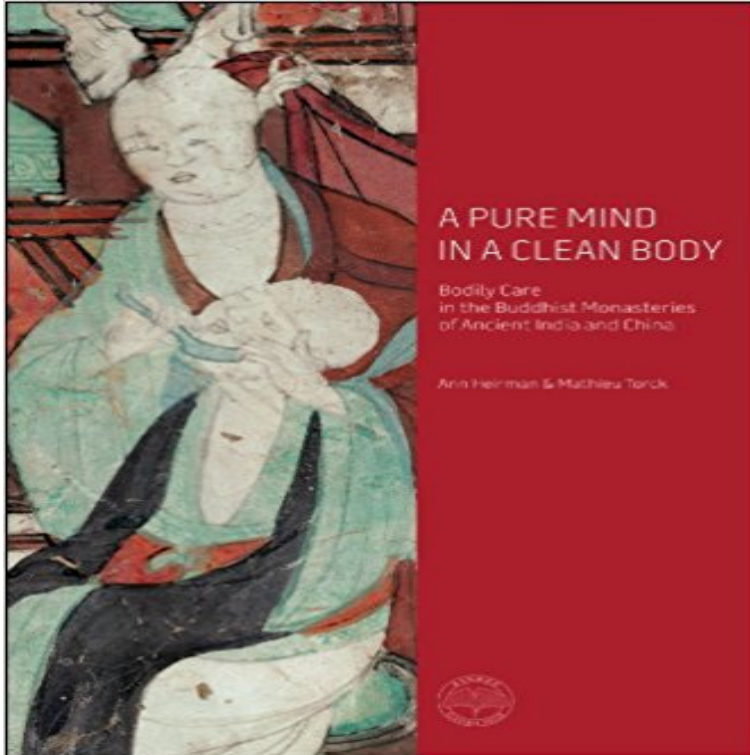


A Pure Mind in a Clean Body: Bodily Care in the Buddhist Monasteries of Ancient India and China

In this sense, they provide a potential bridge between two worlds that are constantly interacting with each other: monastic people and their lay followers.
